## 6.1 FINDING

1. It is observed that in the present manual system the data regarding daily procurement etc is being collected from truck-sheet section.
2. Time required to collect information and generate information is more.
3. Some time information is collected orally, hence there is possibility of incorrect figures.
4. Presently MIS department is not analysing the reports properly.
5. In manual system it takes time to get any previous information.
6. To find previous year data in various reports last years registers are referred at present.
7. It is observed that presently cross check of data is not carried out.
8. Rise in Average milk procurement of cow and buffalo from 1986 to 1991 is slow and since 1991 it is fast.
9. Local milk sale has drastically increased after 1991.
10. There is variation in wholesale milk sale.
11. Milk products production and sale has not definite trend.
12. Various new products has been introduced after 1991.
