CHAPTER-II

PROFILE OF M.I.D.C. INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, KUDAL

2.1 Introduction:

In the five years planning programme of India, the subject of Industrial Estate has got prominent position. The programme of Industrial Estate initially started in India by Small-scale Industries Board in order to develop small-scale industries.

It was claimed to be an important method of fostering the development of the small industrial enterprises, rural industrialization of industrial development. and decentralization The programme industrial estates started towards the end of the First Five Year Plan and has occupied a prominent position in all subsequent development plans. Rapid industrialization was the strong urge behind the establishthe Industrial Estates all over the country. of the small-scale industries in the past four decades has been deliberately and carefully sponsored through a set of policies. Since build infrastructure independence, attempt has been made to small-scale sector and provide finance and other fiscal incentives, all of which have given a push to the growth of small industries.

In the promotional policy for small-scale enterprises, government of India has decided to use industrial estate as an instrument for promotion of small scale enterprises because small-scale industries play very important role in planned industrialization of India. Industrial estate provides organized location to industrial units so that these units can avail themselves of economies of scale.

2.2 Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation:

The Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation been put in charge of all 68 of the industrial estates in the state. It was set up on the 1st August 1962 under the provision of Maharashtra Industrial Development Act 1961, with a view to promoting and assisting growth and development of industries all over the state. The main objective of M.I.D.C. is to achieve balanced industrial development of the entire state with particular emphasis on the development of the industries in the developing parts and for this purpose provide at various locations in each district of the state, basic infrastructure in the form of developed plots, roads, water supply, drainage and common facilaities facilitate entrepreneurs to in setting up industry with ease and speed. For the pricing purposes, M.I.D.C. has divided the state into four groups according to which the rates vary. All developed areas are grouped under 'Group A', the fairly developed are as 'Group B' and 'Group C' refers to less developed areas and 'Group D' as least developed areas. Kudal has under the 'Group D' as least developed area.

2.2.1 Important Activities of M.I.D.C.:

(a) To provide developed plots with clear titles to entrepreneurs for setting up their industries in such plots and also to provide plots for industrial housing and common facilities.

- (b) To provide basic infrastructure in industrial areas like roads, water supply drainage, street light etc..
- (c) To provide facilities/amenities such as built-up accommodafor banks. post offices, telephone/telex tion station, fire station, Employees police State Insurance hospitals, dispensaries, shops Scheme, canteens, etc..
- (d) To make special efforts for encouraging technicians, small scale entrepreneurs, by providing readymade sheds/Galas in various industrial areas and help them in setting up their own industries.
- (e) To provide industrial housing by construction of residential buildings.
- (f) To establish major water supply schemes for helping industrial and urban growth.
- (g) To undertake on behalf of the government/semi-government agencies, projects on deposit contribution basis, since M.I.D.C. has acquired expertise in expeditious implementation of different types of projects, for example, development of film-city

2.3 Profile of M.I.D.C. Kudal Industrial Estate:

According to the government policy, Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation established Kudal Industrial Estate in 1972.

The estate is located in the area of the village Panchayat of Kudal, Pinguli and Nerur. This industrial estate is known as 'Kudal Industrial Estate', as it is only two Km. away from Kudal city.

The total area planned for development in the estate is 275.65 hectares. Out of this 10.72 hectares have been kept as an open area and 4.75 hectares have been kept as reserved. At the end of March 1990, 220 plots are developed with shades and out of this 138 plots are allotted. All the plots are given to the plot holders on a lease basis. According to the rule of M.I.D.C., it normally executes an agreement of lease, which is like a licence to enter upon the land. After substantial utilization of allotted land a long term lease for 99 years is granted by M.I.D.C.. If the allottee does not want to use the land he can give the possession receipt back to M.I.D.C..

The total area covered by these plots is 60.87 hectares. Out of 138 shades 93 shades are in use and the remaining are to be used. By March 1990, 93 industries had started the production and their approximate capital investment was Rs.1,239 lakhs and their annual turnover was Rs.1,357 lacks. They have provided employment to about 450 people.

Most of the plots have been taken up for small-scale industries. The sectoral pattern of industries shows that the largest number of plots are for engineering type of industries as well as plastic type of industries. At the end of March 1990, 138 allotted plots

have been engaged for various purposes as shown below:

- 1. Large-scale units 2
- 2. Medium-scale units 1
- 3. Small-scale units 98
- 4. Commercial purpose 22
- 5. Residential purpose 15

As the allotment of plots has been made to the industrial units, the plots have been allotted to government and semi-government, institutions for their purpose as shown below:

- 1. Post Office 150 Hectares
- 2. Maharashtra Instruments 2.2 Hectares
- 3. Maharashtra State Electricity Board 3.00 Hectares

Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation has made the various facilities available in the estate. The Post and Telegraph office, common facilities centre, dispensary, telephone exchange, police station and a restaurant have been established by a separate plot for each. The plots of two hectares and 7 hectares are allotted for the residential purpose of the W.G. Forge and the Collector of Sindhudurg respectively. Entrepreneurs have been given the remaining 13 plots. Sufficient electricity is provided by the M.S.E.B. with the facility of street-lights.

There is a network of cross-roads in the M.I.D.C. area. These roads are well asphalted and sufficiently wide.

The M.I.D.C. has its own water supply scheme which supplies filtered water. The main connections are given to many residential quarters. This water supply scheme carries the capacity of providing 13,500 cubic meters of water per day. The river-water, which is at two Kilometres distance, has been pumped through the pipes, having 400 mm diametre and stored in the water purification centre. Then it is provided everywhere. A Jackwell with a pump has been built on the bank of a river, Bhangsali. The network of main connection is of 5 Km. length.

M.I.D.C. has constructed and already sold 28 shades in the estate. The shades are given to the entrepreneurs on hire purchase scheme or total cost scheme. The total cost of a shade is Rs. 1,27,200; while purchasing the shade on a hire-purchase basis, 20 per cent amount is to be paid initially and the remaining amount will have to be paid within 7 years.

Hence, it is observed that 19 units out of 93 have closed their production by the end of March 1990. Two large-scale (parent) units like W.G. Forge and Kudal Insulators are closed from 1982. These two units are of engineering types. So, the other engineering units in this area have been affected by the closure of these units. It should be noted that there is a majority of the engineering units in this estate. Out of the remaining 74 functioning units, 23 and 4 units have been declared as sick units by the commercial banks and the Government of Maharashtra respectively.
