

R e c o m m e n d a t i o n s

- 1) In order to perform every increasing functions the municipality require more and more resources. Therefore the system of grants and loans should also be reexamined and should be placed on a surer and dependable footing.

- 2) Sound budgeting is equally important they need to train their budget officers for this purpose. Similarly a good system of continious internal and regular extenal ~~xxx~~ audit must be immediately introduced.

- 3) Sangli Municipalities income from non-tax sources is also meager, they must exploit existing non-taxes resources further.

- 4) Through the income from octroi is significantly high, several methods for the improvement in collection of octroi can be suggested.....
 - a) There should be no exemption even for goods owned by government.
 - b) The collection of tax should not be left entirely in the hands of the subordinate staff, but there should be greater improvement of the supervisory staff.

- c) Checking of goods should be immediately started to detect mal-practices.
- 5) For increasing the income from property tax a uniform methods of property valuation by trained and experienced staff is necessary.
- 6) The periodical revision or reassessment of property value must be done.
- 7) State should give grant in Liew of tax on Government buildings in Municipal area.
- 8) There is a need for restructuring the capital finances of the municipality. The capital finance may be mannaged in the light of the following...
 - i) Prepare city Development plan for Decade (CDP)
 - ii) Identify cost and benefit of each scheme under ~~z~~ CDP.
 - iii) Classify all The schemes under CDP in to three groups viz...
 - a) Remunerative.
 - b) Semi-remunerative.
 - c) Non-remunerative.
