"It has given me immense pleasure to receive in due time your gratifying letter dated the 19th of Shawal (corresponding to the 1st November 1844 A.D.) stating that you made arrangements to render aid to the Political Officers at Belgaum in restoring order in the territory of the Kolhapur State. I have, therefore, the honour to convey to you my grateful thanks for the loyalty you exhibited in supporting the cause of the British Government." (Customary conclusion follows).

APPENDIX-J

Translation of a letter dated the 29th January 1345 from His Excellency the Governor of Bombay to the Chief of Sangli

(Customary greetings, compliments, etc.). "It has given me great satisfaction to know from the Political Agent for the Province of Karnatik that your men distinguished themselves for their great valour in the battle of Vangar-Chavda fought between your soldiers in the personal service in Rajeshri Harihar Dada and a party of rebels under Kalgiri Gosavi. With reference to it I have the honour to convey my grateful thanks to you for the service rendered by you and for the loyal attachment thus shown to Government". (Customary conclusion follows).
