

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the present study and its findings, following recommendations can be put forth.

- [1] The share of women in the beneficiaries was not in accordance with the plan i.e. 30 percent. It should therefore, be implemented accordingly.
- [2] There should be an adequate training facilities for providing training to the beneficiaries before starting the project.
- [3] Beneficiaries should be motivated to ensure that they take full advantage of the scheme in a right manner.
- [4] In identification of beneficiaries, there must be involvement of people's representation. So that, the deserving people would be selected.
- [5] A follow-up programme should be taken by the District Rural Development Agency, Panchayat Samiti, and Gram Panchayat for smooth functioning of different schemes among the beneficiaries.
- [6] A proper infrastructural facilities should be given to the beneficiaries for the effective implementation of schemes like dairing (cows, buffaloes), self employment. etc.
