B) METHODOLOGY AND THE FIELD-WORK

1) Purpose of the Study :

Since no work has been done by Anthropologists on the Mendhe Dhangars of Hatkanangale Taluka, this area of knowledge has remained practically untouched. There are different purposes and objectives inherent in any study of this sphere. While some of them are pure academic, others have important practical application, a few of which are given below :

Despite the constitutional safeguards assured to the members of the Mendhe Dhangars, the desired results to ensure their rise in the social scale and their integration with the main stream of the Hindu Society have been not so far achieved. Their economic, educational and general style of living remain deplorable.

The present work which is a comparative account of the life of culture of the Mendhe Dhangars based on field work in two villages e.g. Pattankodoli and Ghunaki of Hatkanangale Taluka.

The Mendhe Dhangars of Hatkanangale Taluka are mostly landless agricultural labourers/ workers who are totally dependent on the landed higher castes who employ them on casual basis.
