

My principal objective behind the investigation of labour welfare facility in Yashwant Iron & Steel Works limited, Kolhapur is to know the workers expectations.


The distribution of workers according to their age-group.

There is no worker below 18 years.


The distribution of workers according to their work experience in the factory.




Above table shows that C.I.casting production is goes on. Though C.I.casting production has tough compition, company has maintained its market due to good quality & efficient workers.
