Chapter 4

RESEARCH DESIGN.

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4.1 INTRODUCTION

Management is an activity composed fo some basic functions achieving the objectives of an enterprise through the efforts of its personnel. Management is essential for kinds of organisations whether they all be business organisations or non business organisations. This is so as every organisation requires decision making, the coordination of activities. The handling of people and evaluating the performance directed towards its objectives.

The management process constitutes of Planning, Organisation Staffing, Directing, Controlling Motivating, Coordination and Communication. And the functional areas including personal function, finance function, production, marketing function. The study of such management process and functional areas of management is important. Hence our attempt is to study the management process and functional areas of management adopted by the Gadag Co-operative Textile Mill Ltd., and the Farmers Co-operative Spinning Mill Ltd of Gadag Taluka and to suggest some ways and means for effective management.

4.2 OBJECTIVE OF THE STUDY:

The researcher has the following objectives for the purpose of his study.

- 1) To study organisational structure of Gadag Co-operative Textile mill Ltd., and the Farmers Co-operative Spinning mill Ltd.
- 2) To study and examine the management process and functional areas of management adopted.
- ** such as the planning process or various plans prepared and implemented by the two organisation understudy.
- ** Staffing, authority, responsibility and accountability existing.

- ** The measures adopted to co-ordinate the activities of various departments .
- ** The motivational aspects and to probe into the various controlling techniques used.
- ** The functional areas of management like personnel, finance production, and marketing function of two organisations understudy.
- 3) To suggest remedial measures for the efficient functioning of the organisations.

4.3 METHODOLOGY ADOPTED:

Keeping in view the above objectives it was necessary to collect the required data from various sources. The data required for study are collected through questionnaire from selected respondents of various categories such as Workers, Officers and Managers. Besides this the other information is collected through discussions, personal interviews and observations. Similarly data was made available through published material and the records maintained by the factories.

4.4 SOURCES OF DATA COLLECTIONS:

For the purpose of the present study relevant information is collected through various sources such as primary sources and secondary sources.

4.4.1 PRIMARY DATA :

Primary data is collected through the following ways :

- i) QUESTIONNAIRE: Two different questionnaires were prepared and administered. One was meant to elicit the information about the management process adopted by the organisations and other was to get the information about the functional areas of management of the organisation understudy.
- ii) DISCUSSIONS AND INTERVIEWS AND OBSERVATIONS: The detailed discussion with some Directors, Managing Directors, Office superintendents, supervisors, Accountants, personnel officers, workers were held. Similarly structural interview were held with the employees and employers to cross examine the management process adopted by the organisation and some data were collected by using observation method. The safety measures, and welfare facilities provided to the employees were observed.
