CHAPTER - V

PROMOTION :-

Promotion is a term which covers a change and calls for greater responsibilities and usually involves higher pay and better terms and conditions of service and therefore, a higher status or rank.

Life Insurance Corporation at Divisional level pre-promotional coaching classes were conducted for promotion to cadre of Higher Grade Assistants, Assistants and Record Clerks, Promotions were effected and educational qualification, period of service and various sports activities were considered.

Educational qualification, length of service, efficiency are considered for promotion to the cadre of Asst. Administrative Officers and Administrative Officers.
