Working of Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai.

3.1 Introduction

Farmers sell the agricultural products to the customers with the help of middlemen. But generally farmers are illiterate and middlemen exploit the farmers. Regulated markets are securing established for the purpose of security the interest of the farmers. Regulated Markets provide various facilities for selling and buying of agricultural produce to the farmers as well as the traders. Regulated markets established in Wai area provide various facilities for sales transactions of agricultural produce. Sub Market Yards of Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai also take care for sales transactions. In this chapter we have to study the working of krushi utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai in detail.

3.2 Profile of Satara District

In Mahaashtra State. Agricultural produce Market committees are divided in four regions namely Aurangabad, Nagpur, Pune and Mumbai. In Pune region are included Pune, Ahmednagar, Satara, Kolhapur, Sangli & Solapur districts.

In Satara district Satara, Krushi Utpanna Bazar, Samittee Satara came into existence on 29th Oct 1965. It has '4' sub Market committees. In Satara district other market committees are also working. Those are Dhivadi, Karad, Koregaon, Lonand, Patan, Phaltan, Vaduj, Wai and Jawali. Each Market committee has its Sub Marekt Yards. Dhivadi Market committee has '2' sub Market yards.

Karad Market committee has '2' sub Market yards, Koregaon Market Committee has '2' sub Market yards. Lonand Market Committee has '2' sub Market yards. Market yards Patan, Phaltan and Wai Market committees have '3' subs Market yards in their areas. Vaduj and Jawali Market Committees have '2' sub Market yards.

The following table shows the detailed information regarding various Market committees in Satara district

3.3 Profile of Wai Taluka.

In Maharashtra state, there are a large number of Regulated Markets. According to geographical condition, farmers produce a particular agricultural Product and sell through Regulated Markets. So according to maximum particular agriltural product a regulated market is identified. For this research work, Wai Taluka is selected. This Wai Taluka is located in Satara District.

3.3.1 Wai Taluka's Administrative area

For this research work Krushi Utpanna Bazar Sammittee, Wai in Satara district is selected. This Market committee is Located at 'Yashwantnagar' in Wai Taluka. The main office and main building

of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai is located in 'Yashwantangar' area. This main office is 3-4 kms form Wai city on the Wai Satara Road. The Main building is situated near the main road. Building is on one side and market place is on the other side. Other Sub Markets are situated in Panchwad 10 kms away from Wai and at Surur, 10 kms away from Wai and Bhuij, 9 kms away from Wai

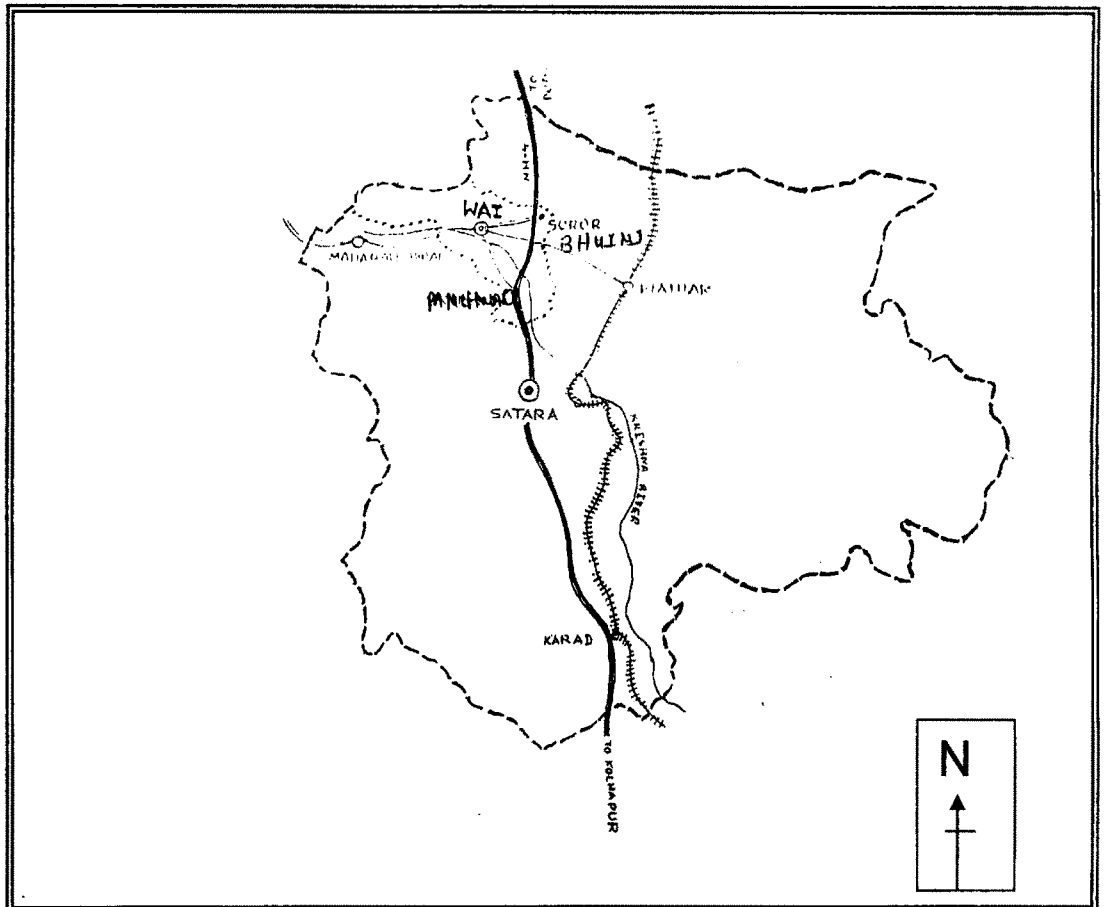
In Wai area, farmers generally produce turmeric. So Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai mainly deals with turmeric. In Wai Market Yard farmers from Jawali and Mahabaleshwar Taluka sell their Turmeric. This is suitable for them because they are near to Wai Taluka. In Satara district there are other Regulated Markets also, but Wai Market is mainly identified for 'Turmeric'.

Regulated Market in Wai is working mainly in to Wai Taluka area and mainly working for turmeric. In addition to turmeric, vegetables, fruits. Flowers are sold and purchased in Wai Market Yard. The Panchwad Sub- Market Yard mainly deals with cattle. In Panchwad Sub Market Yard bulls, cow, she-buffalos, he-buffalos, goats sold & purchased by the farmers. In Surur and Bhuij sub Market Yards vegetables & fruits are & purchased.

3.3.2 Principal Market and Sub- Market yards Locations

1) Location

Map shown in geographical location of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai

The above Map shows that the main Market yard i.e. Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai is located at Yashwanagar and other sub Market Committees are located at Panchwad, Bhujinj and Surur. These Sub Market Yards have started after starting of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai The Sub Markets work under Principal Market Yard.

3.4 The Administrative Setup

3.4.1 The Beginning

Krushu Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai has been operating for Wai Tahsil. This market yard is a part of or sub market of Satara Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee. In 1981 Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai, separated from Satara Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee. Since then Wai Market Yard is separately working as Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai.

From 1981 to 1993 main building of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai was taken on rental basis in Municipal Council building from 15 th Aug 1993 Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai has been working in its own building.

Up to 22nd Dec 2005 Mahabaleshwar Market Yards was included in Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai as Sub- Market Yard. But since 2005 Mahabaleshwar Market Yard has been working under Jawali Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee.

3.4.2 The Principal Market Yard and Sub Market Yards

Wai Market yard was firstly introduced in Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai and is working for Wai Tahsil.

i) Principal Market

At Yashwantnagar Wai the Principal Market Yard is established. Total area covered by the main Market Yard is 2.54 hectores

The following table shows the development of the Principal Market Yard.

The above table shows the total area used by Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai. For office building 3,500 sq. feet, For shopping Center 4,160 sq feet, For sale hall 19,200 sq feet for shade No. 1 - 4,400 sq feet For shade No. 2 - 3,200 sq feet. For water tank and well 1,000 sq feet For Internal roads 35,000 sq feet and remaining space is used for them Market Yard.

ii) Sub Market Yards

Wai Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee has '3' sub Market Yards. Panchwad Sub Market yard developed in 27,500 sq feet. For Bhuinj Sub- Markets 38,155 sq feet and area used.

This area is taken on rental basis. For Surur sub Market yard there is no particular space

Explanation

The above table shows the various members of Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai. Once these members are elected then they work for 5 years. Their working period is for 5 years.

The Members elected from agriculturist are '9' our of which '2' are women '4' members are elected from Local authority out of

which 'One' post is reserved for ST or SC Category. From traders '2' members are elected. 'One' member is from Hamals. Reserved sit for co-op societies, Chariman or the Vice Chairman Panchyat Samittee and Grampanchyat elected their 'One' member separately. All these members are elected according to Section 13 Amendments Act 1986.

The secretary of Bazar Samittee is also a member but he doesn't have voting right but he has a right to take part in the discussion of the Committee.

3.4.4 Appointment of chairman and Vice – Chairman

Chairman and vice chairman play most important role in the working of regulated Markets. According to sub section (2) of section 13, every Market Committee shall be presided over by a Chairman, who shall elected by the Committee from among its [Selected Agriculturist members]. The committee shall also elect one of its [elected Agriculturist members] to be the Vice – Chairman.

On the constitution of the Market Committee after a general election or other wise, the collector or the offices not lower. In rank than that of a Deputy Collector as the Collector may authorize in this behalf [there in after in this election sections referred to as "the authorized officer"] shall, within 30 days from the publication of the result of the general election under clause (a) or as the case may be, under clause (b) sub- section (4) of section 14 call a meeting for the election of the Chairman and the Vice- Chairman.

Such meeting shall be presided over by the [Collector or the authorized officer. The Collector or such authorized officer] shall, when presiding over the meeting, have the same powers as the Chairman when presiding over a meeting of the Market Committee has but shall not have the right to vote.

If, in the election of a Chairman or Vice chairman there is an equity of votes, the result of the election shall be decided by lots to be drawn in the presence of the officer presiding in such manner as he may determine.

In the event of a dispute arising as to the validity of the election of a Chairman or Vice-Chairman, the [Collector], if he is the presiding officer shall decide the dispute himself and in any other case the officer presiding shall refer the dispute to the [Collector] the decision. The decision of the [Collector], subject to an appeal to the [Commissioner appointed under section 6, of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1996] shall be final & not suit or other proceeding shall lie in any court in respect of any such decision.

3.5 Administrative Personnel

For regular working administrative staff is appointed by Regulate Markets. This staff is appointed according to Section 35 of Market Act 1963. The secretary shall be Chief Executive Officer. He is the custodian of the records and properties of the Market Committee. All posts other than that of a secretary shall be created with the prior approval of the director. This entire staff is required for day working. Hence we are taking detailed information about administrative staff of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai

3.5.1 Secretary

Secretary is the most important person working in Regulated Market. Secretary is the executive officer of the Market Committee. He has to work under the control of Market committee. He can advice to the Market Committee if it is acting in any way contrary or prejudicial to the APMC Act and there under and should give his opinion in writing if the Market committee is operating and asking the Secretary to act contrary to the to the provisions of the APMC Act and Rules there under.

In the life of Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee Wai 4 secretaries worked there. First secretary was appointed as per the ruled and regulations of APMC Act 1963. Second secretary took additional charge for 3 years from 1989 to 1992 3rd secretary appointed on deputation. He took charge for 2 years from 1992 to 1994 and 4th secretary is promoted. He is working from 1st March 1994 onwards. All secretaries are appointed according to rules and regulation included in APMC Act 1963.

3.5.2 Administrative Staff

For regular working, administrative staff is appointed. The appointment of another staff has to be made by Market committee subject to the approval of Director or other officers to whom powers of Director are delegated. This staff is required for regular working administration and management of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai.

Following table shows the number of persons working in Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai as an administrative staff.

Explanation

The above table shows the required staff and actual staff appointed by Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai

Administrative staff is decided into '3' categories these are officer, Senior Grade Staff and Junior Grade office staff.

For the principal Market yard, In first category 'One' secretary 'One' Assistant secretary and 'One' Accountant are required Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai also appointed '3' persons as a secretary, Assistant secretary and Accountant.

In second category there are '2' Market Supervisors and Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee also appointed 'One' supervisors as a actual staff 'One' Market Inspectors and 'One' statistical Assistant required, Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai appointed these posts. But in the case of junior clerk there are '6' clerks required and Market committee appointed '4' clerks. It has also appointed 'One' grader.

In third category, 'One' watchman and '4' Peons are required according to Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai has appointed the 'One' watchman and '1' Peons as a actual staff. In case of appointment of the Driver there is no provision, so Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai hasn't appoint a driver required for sub Market Yard one Junior clerk & One peon is required But Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai appoints only one peon for Sub Market Yard.

3.6 Market Yard

In Wai Taluka Regulated Market is established in 1981 for providing market place for the farmers and the traders. In Wai area at Yashwantnagar Principal Market yard is developed and other sub market yards are developed in the Taluka Places.

3.6.1 Site for the Principal Market Yard

The Principal Market Yard Located in Yashwantangar at Wai Taluka The Principal Market yard is 3-4 k.m

The total area of Principal Market Yard is 2.54 hector. Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai according to their needs, develops this area. In Principal Market yard it develops office building shopping Centre, sale hall, shades, well & water tank internal roads and remaining space is used for market. In this market yard Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai has started daily market. This Market Yard is suitable to the farmers as well as the traders because it is located on the main road. Transportation of goods is easy, so it is convenient to the farmers and the traders.

3.6.2 Site for sub Market yards

Sub Market yards of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee have located at Panchwad, Bhuinj, and Surur areas.

Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai, purchases yard the space. This sub Market Yard opens on every Tuesday. This sub Market Yard is popular for cattle Market & especially for bull Market. Total area of Panchwad sub Market Yard is 27,500 sq feet. In this area it develops cattle-hospital, cattle-shade, Receipt office

water tank and internal roads. Remaining space is used for marketing. This market is also convenient for the traders and the farmer because it is located on Mumbai –Banglore Highway and it is 10 k.m. Away from Wai City.

For Bhuij Sub Market Yard Land taken by Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai on rental basis. For this Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai makes '99' years contract to Bhuij Grampanchyat This sub Market Yard is located on Mumbai- Benglore Highway and 10 k.m. away from wai. In this market Yard it develops go downs market place and internal roads.

Third Sub- Market Yard of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai at Surur town. This yard is 10 k.m.away this sub market Yard there is no space taken either rental basis or purchased by Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai. But daily market is organized on the road. It is known as topali- Bazar.

3.6.3 Godowns

For the marketing purpose Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai has provided shops to the traders in the shopping center. In Principal Market Yard and sub Market Yard it has opened number of shops. The farmers as well as the traders used as godowns or as a shops. Generally they stored their agricultural produce in it. Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee has only one godown. The capacity of this godown is 200 Metric Tones. This godown is in the Bhuij Sub Market Yard. In other market Yards they have no godowns. But they have shopping centers. This one godown is started on rental basis. Traders or the farmers have taken it on rental basis. They make

contract between the traders or the farmers and Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai for a specific period.

3.6.4 Storage Capacity and co-operative Market

1) Storage Capacity

Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai has not their own storage. So they haven't provided storage facility to the traders. The traders and the farmers are using private storage system.

2) Co-operative Market

In Wair Taluka there are various co-operative societies opened for developing the market habits of the customers as well as the traders.

Following are the various co-operative institutions, which are helpful for favorable marketing & agricultural produce

- 1) Kisan Veer Co-operative Sugar Factory Bhuj
- 2) Co-operative Cotton mill, Bavdan
- 3) Gram Vikas co-op society, Wai.
- 4) Wai Taluka Sale & Purchase Union Ltd., Wai.

These institutions purchased agricultural products from the farmers directly. They also paid fair prices for their agricultural products. Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai has not interfered in these transactions. From these co-operative societies '7' members are elected. These members are working as a Director in Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai. These co-operative societies secure the rights of the farmers. When

farmers sell these institutions do not exploit their products directly to these societies in those transaction farmers. So these institutions are providing market place for agricultural produce to the farmers in Wai area.

3.6.5 Development of Market Yard

Before 1981 Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai was the Sub Market Yard of Satara Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai Satara. But in 1981 it was separated. Now it is known as Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai.

At that time the main office building was located in one room in the Municipal building of Wai city. That room was taken on rental a basis. Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai used regular Market place

But on 15th Aug 1993 total working of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai was shifted to its own office building. For this purpose it purchased 2.54hector place on Wai Satara Road 3-4 km away from wai city. In this area Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai developed office-building shades, sale hall, internal roads and remaining space is used for market yard.

When Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai started as Principal Market Yard that times it started Cattle Market at Panchwad town. This market is known as ‘Sub- Market Yard’ of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai. For this cattle market Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai, purchased 27,500 sq feet area. In this area Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai developed cattle hospital, internal roads, cattle shade, receipt office, water tank and remaining

space is used for market. This market is usually opens on every Tuesday.

Krushu Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai also started other two Sub Market Yards at Bhuinj and Surur area. For Bhuinj Sub Market place has taken on rental basis from Bhuinj Grampanchyat. For this Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee make an agreement with Bhuinj Grampanchayat for 99 years. In this place 10 shopping centers are opened and providing to the leraders for the farmers as rental basis. In Surur villiage daily market has started. But no place has purchased by Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai. But for this purpose regular market area use by Krushi Utpanna Bazar samittee, Wai for daily market.

3.7 Benefits of Market committee

For securing the benefits of the farmers and the traders Regulated Market is developed in Wai area. Regulated Market of Wai also provided market place for selling and purchasing of agricultural produce to the farmers and the traders.

The following points show the benefits to the farmers and the traders.

1) Reduction in village sales-

The establishment of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai has led to decrease in village sales. The grower sellers are made aware at the fair practices in this Regulate Market Now they brings the salable produce to this Market Yard. The agricultural goods brought to markets have risen from 20% to

95% large number of the farmers in villages gets a market for their products.

2) Fair Prices

The prices determined in this Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai are fair and reasonable to both the producers as well as the dealers and not one sided. Thus the farmers are assured of getting higher share in the price. Market Prices are regulated and made uniform. This is done by bringing the market functionaries under strict control. Each of the buyers has a chance to complete and procure his needs according to his capacity in the 'close bid' system of auction.

3) Correct Weighment

There was manipulation in weighing, prior to the establishment of this Market Yard. But now they have introduced correct weights and measures in the markets. Licensed weigh men do weighing. Hand balances are replaced by beam-balances and weights bridges. Metric system of Weight men is adopted. The weights are also standard raised now. This assures correct weighing to the farmers and thus eliminates manipulation in weights.

4) Reduction in market charges

The Market Committee, Wai, prescribes payments of commission, weighing charges, brokerage hamali, charities, etc. Thus all the unauthorized deductions are prohibited. Thus, the farmer's share in the actual price has increased. Prior to

regulation, these marketing charges varied from the market, with an average of 3.41% now have come down to 1.79% resulting a saving of 1.62%

5) Marketing Services

Grading of agricultural goods has been accepted as one of the important function of Regulated Markets It solves many problems like better prices, continued market, etc. Agmarks standards has been accepted by all and that is why today we see this mark on the packages of many products like grains, honey, ghee, vanaspathi etc which speaks of the quality. It becomes easy to determine the price.

6) Marketing facilities

The Regulated Markets like drinking water facility for both human beings and animals, parking arrangements farmer's auction sheds, weighing, etc. are providing the numbers of facilities. All these amenities are available only in the regulated markets.

7) Market News

The dissemination of market information and news has been regarded as an important service function to be performed by the Market Committee. The prices ruling in various markets are exhibited on the notice board. Now the prices of the commodities are being announced through board casting on all Indian or regional levels.

To conclude the Regulated Market Yard of Wai plays a vital role in removing the majority of the defects and malpractices and there fore, it operated on proper lines, in those areas where they are present by their absence. Regulated Market yard also secures the rights of the farmers and the traders.

3.8 Regulated Agricultural Commodities and cattle

Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai regulates the some agricultural goods. It mainly deals with those agricultural produce mentioned in the Government Resolution.

Following table shows the agriculture commodities are regulated and on which date they are regulated.

On 2nd Feb 1981 Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai had registered 8 cattle. Panchwad sub- Market Yard handles selling and purchasing of these cattle every week on Tuesday in this sub-Market Yard all records about cattle are maintained.

Krushu Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai, maintains all records of agricultural commodities and cattle.

3.9 License Fees, Market Fees and other Charges

Source of income of Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee, Wai is the License fees the market fees and the other charges. From those sources the Market Yard collects the incomes. These are the internal sources of income of the market Yard. These fees are charging on selling and purchasing transaction of agricultural good. The other

sources of income included sale of property, sale of grass, interest on investment, etc.

The following table shows the License fees are payable by the Market Intermediaries annually to the Krushi Utpanna Bazar Samittee Wai.
