1.	Storage of clay, Tractors are used to bring clay from the clay-lands.	32A
2.	A required quantity of clay is again dug out manually from the clay heaps located near the brick-making yard.	32A
3.	Coal ash is separated manually with the help of sievers.	33A
4.	Clay-mixing team cutting the soil, cleaning it and making ready for moulding by mixing right quantity of coal-ash and water.	33A
5.	Well mixed soil is put in the shape of a mound and is ready for moulding.	34A
6.	Moulding operation is in progress - the mould, steel pallet etc. can be seen.	34A
7.	Bricks removed from the mould are Laid on the levelled ground for sun drying.	41A
8.	After 3 to 4 days the bricks are kept in this position for sun-drying for an additional period of 2 to 3 days before they are put-in the kin.	41A
9.	Brick transporting team transporting sun-dried bricks to kiln for arrangement.	42A
