<u>CHAPTER-VI</u>

SOCIO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEME

An attempt has been made to evaluate the developmental activities undertaken by the factory, in view to bringing about social economic changes within the jurisdiction of the factory. It is important to note that this factory has given due consideration to this aspect. The developmental activities basically include education(primary, High-school, Colleges) Social forestry and other social activities. The Shetakari Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana has opened primary Schools, high schools, colleges in rural area. In addition, this factory has been providing financial assistance to the other educational institutions.

As it has been observed from Table No. 6.1. that the expenditure on developmental activities has been increasing significantly over a period of time. For instance Rs. 3.52 lakhs were spent during 1971-72 which increase to 1.29 crores during 1981-86. Moreover, of the total collected money higher proportion of it has been used for these activities. It was around 81% of the total collected money in 1971-72 which increased to 94.4% during 1981-85.

6.1 EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES :

Moreover, the factory has given due importance to the development of educational facilities in this regions In this regards this factory has opened several educational institutions in rural area, in view to provide educational facilities to the rural masses.

A) SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES :

1) <u>KINDERGARTEN</u> :

Factory has opened K.G. Schools for the children of factory employees, in the campus. It has also started some Balwadies in the economically backward area through Vasant Dada Vikas Pratisthan and its expenditure is borne by Vasant Dada Vikas Pratistan (Foundation).

2) **PRIMARY SCHOOLS** :

Factory has also opened some primary schools for the children of workers in the factory campus. Economic aids are also given by factory for such schools.

3) SHANTINIKETAN VIDYAMANDIR :

For the children of workers and for the children of residents in the working area of the factory has founded residential Shantiniketan. It gives standard and higner education. For that factory has given 44 lakhs rupees. In the Shantinketan Vidyamandir residential education 1s given. There are Kanya Vidyalaya, Shantiniketan Vidyamandir and Shantiniketan College. From the Shantinikatan College so far hundred students are admitted to medical course and hundred students were admitted to engineering college. For the college there are two hostels in the beautiful natural surrounding. There is a separate ladies hostel also. For the teachers there is also teachers colony. All these buildings are built up by this sugar factory.

4) KALA VISHVA MAHAVIDYALAYA :

This Mahavidyalaya is run by Nav Bharat Shikshan Mandal. It is an **Sut** standing college in Maharashtra.

5) MODERN ENGLISH SCHOOL :

Factory also runs modern English School which gives education through english medium.

6) POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE :

Factory has also established, one Sanstna named Shetakari Shikshan Mandal. It runs Padmabhushan Vasantrao Dada Patil Institute of Technology from the year 1983. For this college factory has provided separate building and educational campus and following other facilities.

- i) Educational Buildings.
- ii) Laboratories.

iii) Workshops.

iv) Restaurants.

More than 800 students have been benifited because of this college factory has spent 5 crores rupees for the college which owned 32 acres land. For the last wtwo years the results of the engineering college is 100%. So many students passed in distinction and in first class.

The factory has specially provided 50% concession to the children of share holders and employees. Because of this polytechnic college students from rural area are getting higher technical education. In the present educational system importance is given to professional education and it is satisfied by the same college. In addition to this, Vasant Dada Vikas foundation started New I.T.I. course in Miraj M.I.D.C. students from this area are enjoying benefit of it.¹

B) FINANCIAL AIDS TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE :

As it can be noticed from Table No. 6.2 that the factory has made significant efforts to expand educational facilities by giving financial aids to the educational institutions such as Balwadi, Primary school, secondary school and college in rural area.

Vasant Dada Vikas Pratishtan has provided toys and snacks to Balwadi and water pots to the primary schools in their working area. Factory has granted aids for construction of school buildings, ground levelling and purchasing of educational instruments to the secondary school during 1981 to 1987 as below.

It is seen from the table that the factory has taken constructive steps for the progress of various educational institutions.

6.3 VASANT GHARKUL SCHEME :

From the 1975, sugar factory supplied homes to the poor people in commanding area, sugar factory provided newly constructed ciment concrete homes to the 1200 landless and homeless people. The cost of the same is Rs. 30 lakhs. Said homes are well equiped with modern amenities. Proposed scheme continued for further period

6.4 OTHER FUNCTIONS :

A) GAMES :

Above mentioned sugar factory has achieved remarkable success in inter Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana competation arranged by sugar association Bombay. Also Karkhana has granted aids to the various Kreeda Mandals in area for holding Kho-kho, Kabbadi, Volley ball computations. Also factory arranges annually wrestling competition for the encouragement of wrestlers in the area and big prizes are distributed for the progress of the wrestling.

B) AIDS TO THE YUVAK MANDAL

Factory has given ad-hoc grants from Rs. 500 to 5000 Rs. to the registered Yuvak Mandal for the benefit works in the area. So far the factory has granted Rs. 28627 to 29 Yuvak mandal in 1986-87.

C) <u>MEDICAL BENEFITS</u> :

Various medical camps of various places were arranged by sugar factory for the **be**nefit of people. Further the factory also arranges such camps with the help of voluntary institutions.

The factory has held camps for eyes, teeth, general camps and supplies free medicines. In the family planning camps 615 males and 2530 females were operated.

The factory helped the late Dr. Shri. Yeshwantrao Jadhav in founding Vasantdada Polio Centre at Kupwad on their own plot. For the benefit of suffering countrywide Polio Paients, so far the costs on account of expansion on these account is Rs. 70701.50.

D) AIDS TO VARIOUS MANDALS :

Karkhana has provided financial aids to the various Mandals i.e. Natya Mandal, B_hajani Mandal, Lezim Pathak, etc. for purchasin of instruments.

E) ENCOURAGEMENT TO WRESTLING :

The establishment has helped to encourage the wresting by constructing Vyayamshala on factory site and also holds annual wrestling competations. The wrestles from this **Y**yayamshala **Weve** worm national awards.

F) MULTIPURPOSE HALLS :

The said establishment (Factory) has constructed multipurposehalls at factory place, Kakadwadi and at Tasgaon for benefit of the rural people. Such as marriages meeting and together etc.²

G) <u>TEMPLES</u> :

They also raised funds for establishment of new temples and undertook renovations of dilapidated temples in its area. So far amount of Rs. 934701 has been spent on more than 250 temples.

H) BORING AND BLASTING SUBSIDY :

Major area of the field of this industry affected by drought from 1972 and it caused drastic effect to sugar cane product. The factory under reference has typied its best to increased availability of water by boring and blasting scheme. The factory has accounted for Rs. 15745907 under this scheme during 1985-86. Out of which 70 lakhs has been subsidy.

This factory has granted grants in aid to 'Thibak Sinchan' scheme to producer sugarcane using less water.

I) CATTLE FEED AND POULTRY FEED :

The establishment has erected cattle feed plant in 1972 by investing Rs. 20 lakhs which is producting foods of 14000 M.T. cattle feed and 21 M.T. poultry feed.³
