Mr. John Thackeray, Chief Collector and Political
Agent, Subah Dharwar to the Chief of Sangli

(Customary greetings, compliments, etc.). "There was an outbreak of revolt in the Kittoor territory ... To suppress it Mr. Nilkanthrao called for several sowars from you, collected some men, remained present with Government Officers engaged on active duty, and exerted himself to his utmost in putting down the revolt. This gave immense pleasure to me. Your men rendered great help to Government. Recently the said Rao has been granted leave to return. Besides this the sowars who were sent for being stationed in this part and those who were with the Rao have also been given leave and sent back ..."
