Translation of a letter dated the 13th August 1845 from His Excellency the Governor of Bombay to the Chief of Sangli

(Customary greetings, compliments, etc.). "It has given me immense pleasure to receive in due time your letter of the 29th Shawal (corresponding to the 11th November 1844 A.D.) requesting that the Government Resolution of September 1844 to take over the two villages Yelwatee and Hollapur and incorporate them into the territory of Government be reconsidered, and an order be passed restoring the said villages to you. I have the honour to state, with reference to it, that the Political Agent, Karnatik, has been addressed to hand over the said villages to you without delay, in appreciation of the valuable aid given by you on the occasion of the recent revolt in the Kolhapur territory and in due recognition on the part of the British Government of your friendly conduct." (Customary conclusion follows).

APPENDIX-L

Translation of a letter dated the 16th of April 1846 from His Excellency the Governor of Bombay to the Chief of Sangli.

(Customary greetings, compliments etc.). "The Honourable Court of Directors have sent a sword to be presented to you in testimony of their respect for your high character and in acknowledgement of your unswerving fidelity and attachment to the British Government. I have great pleasure in forwarding it to you with this letter." (Customary conclusion follows).
