SUGGESTIONS

- (1) As far as co-ordination among the development departments and monitoring the schemes are concerned, there is an urgent need for overhauling the present block level set up to ensure the success of the programme.
- (2) Steps may be taken to achieve co-ordination linkages between D.R.D.A. and various Development Departments, Regional Rural Banks, training institutions, etc.
- (3) It is suggested that the B.D.O. must take more responsibility in identifying and selecting the deserving candidates under IRDP.
- In the present structure and set up there is nobody to co-ordinate various Government departments. As a result many agencies work independently. It is suggested that a social worker with the knowledge and skill in Community Development may be appointed to co-ordinate the various Government departments involved in the upliftment of the poor.
- There is also a dire need for increasing awareness among the beneficiaries about the special programmes meant for their welfare.
