

- 2) In-depth study of households by research institutions is necessary for preparing the list of below poverty line households in the villages.
- 3) There is a need of training regarding utilization of loan amount. Such training should be immediately imparted .i.e. just after sanctioning the loan amount.
- 4) Many beneficiaries reported that the assistance amount sanctioned for assets was inadequate. Therefore, assistance amount should be increased by taking into consideration the current market rates of assets.
- 5) A number of beneficiaries were not having updated bank pass book with them. The bank pass books should be made available to them.
- 6) Asset verification was not done. This should be made compulsory, because, this will help to avoid the possible misutilization of asset by the beneficiaries.
- 7) The evaluation studies of IRDP should be conducted by the experts and scholars from time to time.
