CHAPTER 6

6.1 Conclusions :-

The following are the findings given as below :

- The present manual working system consummes much time and man-power.
- 2. The revenue collection of Kolhapur District is more as compare to Satara and Sangli districts.
- 3. The revenue collection is more with respect to Private sector vehicles than Public sector vehicles.
- It is observed that there is a substantial increase in the number of vehicles in district.
- 5. It is observed that pollution spreading Vehicles are increasing.
- Presently the Regional Transport Office is computerising registration of vehicles. They are yet to Computerise Tax Collection procedures.
- 7. It is observed that in classwise collection BMV Tax collection is considerabley high as compare to Rojgar Hami Yojana and Permit fee.
- B. In two wheelers the number of motor vehicle 'Scooters' is more.
- 9. In case of Cars the cars are generally preferred in Government offices.

- 10. In case of Flying squad raids the number of checked vehicles is more.
- 11. In case of Check-Post (R.T.O.Checkpost,G.S.,Kagal)the number of trials(cases) is remarkably high.
- 12. The revenue collected under the head 'Tax Act & Fee' is more as compared to other heads.
- 13. The number of Autorikshaw/Taxi complaints is considerably increased and revenue collected is less.
