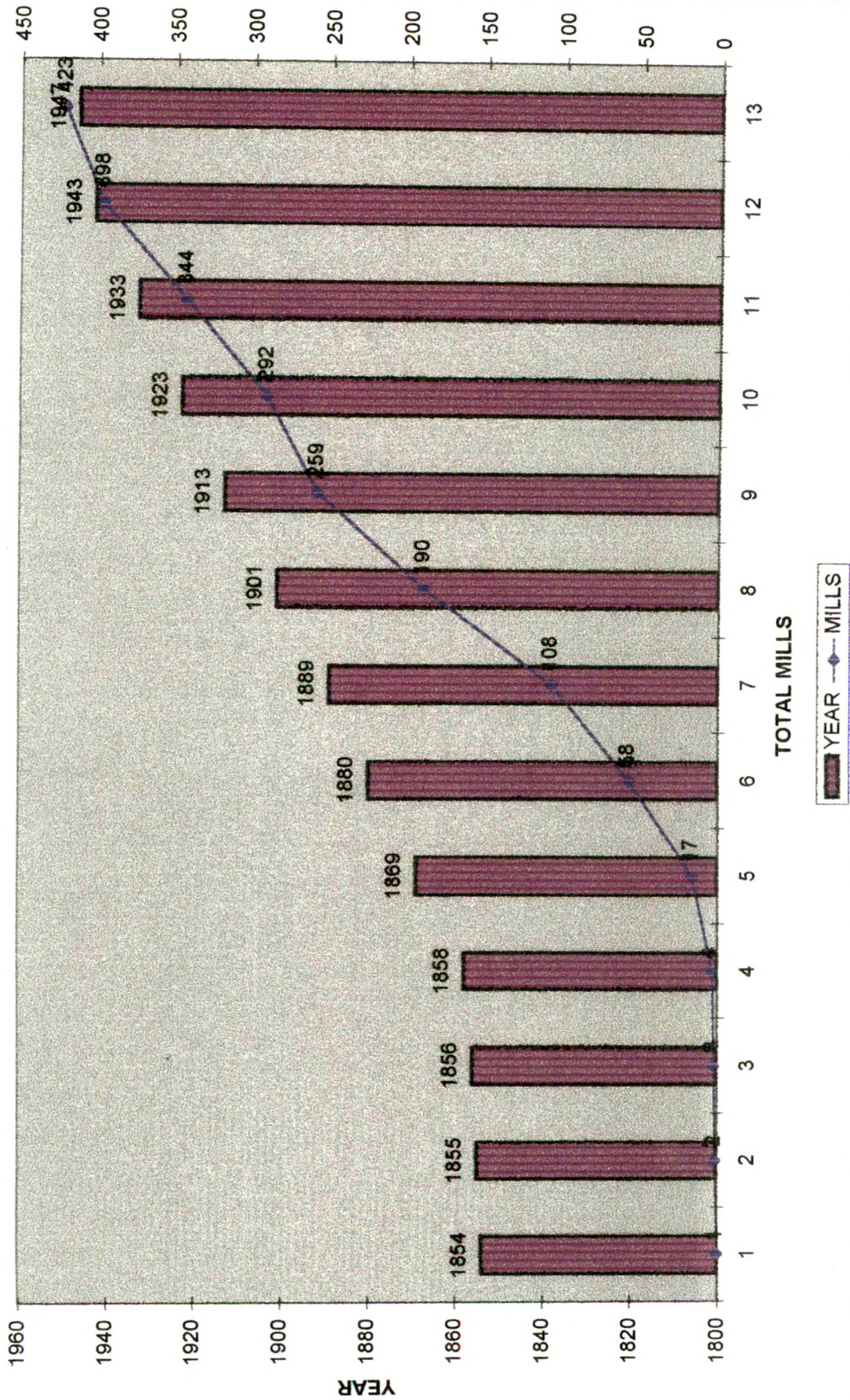

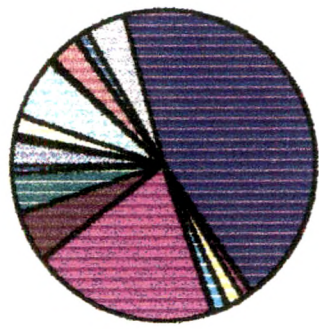

GRAPH SHOWING GROWTH OF TEXTILE INDUSTRY IN INDIA



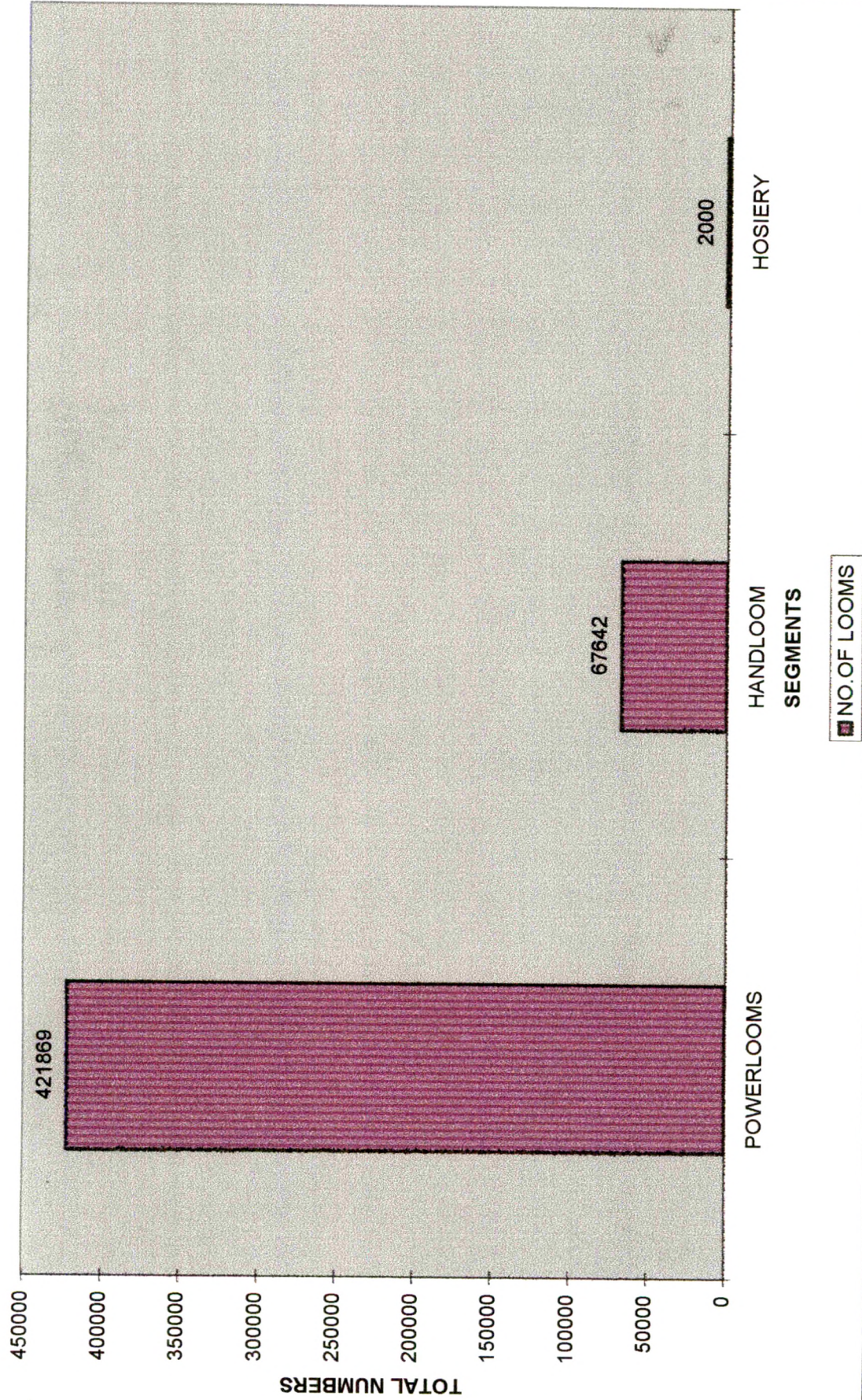
GRAPH SHOWING TOTAL POWERLOOMS IN  
INDIA IN 1981-82



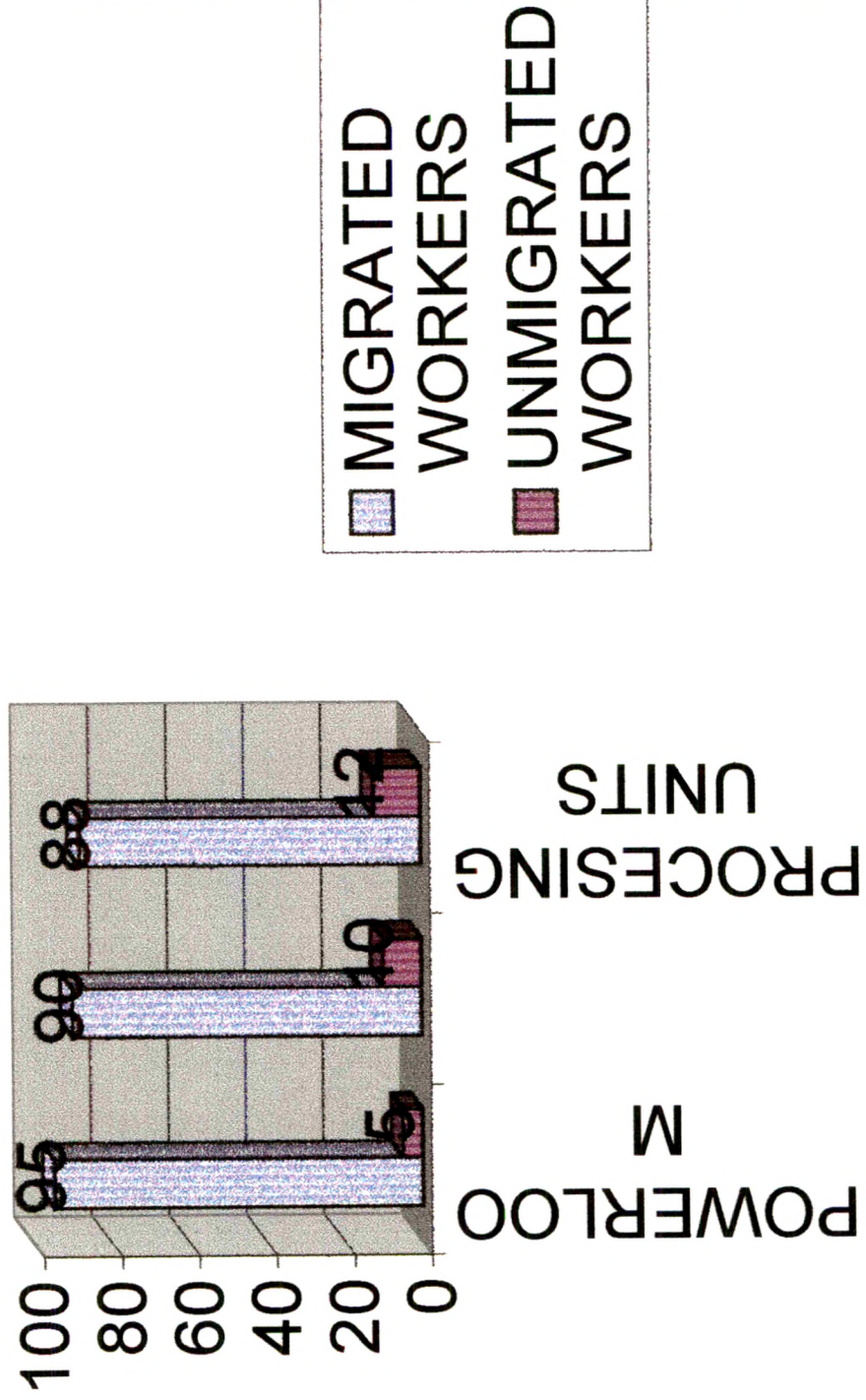

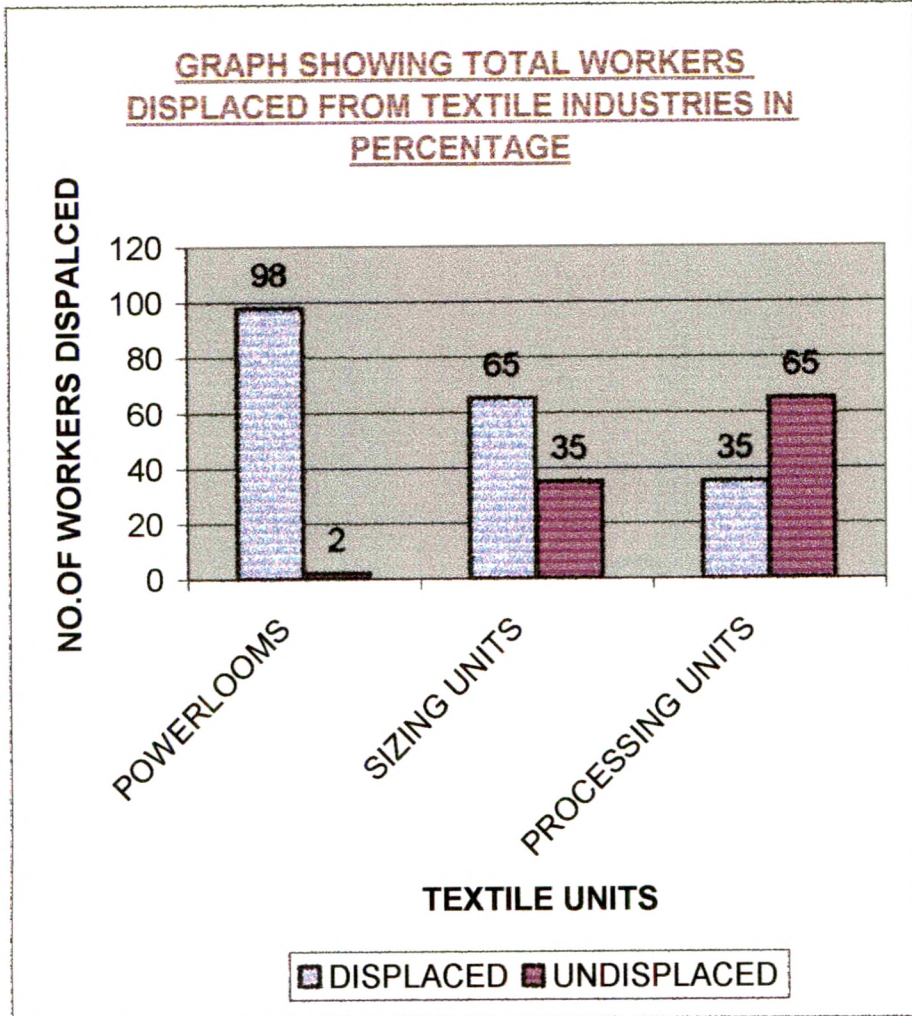
GRAPH SHOWING POWERLOOMS IN MAHARASHTRA

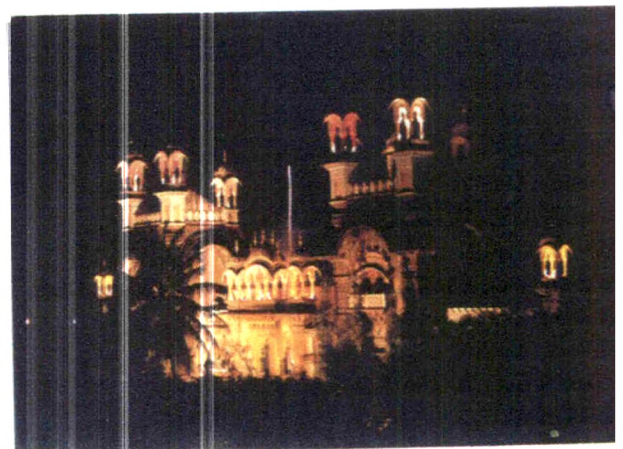
